

Food supply adequate


Farmers <2% of workers

Enough materials and workers to provide necessities




Many heavy, manual labor occupations down

Construction work is steady




Motor Vehicle operators, Stock Clerks and Order Fillers up

Cashiers and Fast Food Workers slightly down




Customer service up

Huge gains






# Increase of Al Ability

Soon to surpass "Smart High Schooler"


Uncertain job security for all levels in near future

With Plan - 13%



# Are Americans Stressed?


Inverse of a normal distribution
